Sandalwood

Aloes, as it was called in biblical times, is an Anatolian sandalwood, and is not to be confused with Aloe Vera.

Sandalwood has been used in India for thousands of years in order to

- Support meditation
- Strengthen prayer
 - Quite the mind

Sandalwood quiets down to the mental chit chat which prevents us from meditation. It enables our spirit to dive into the deepest planes of meditation and connects us to the cosmic spirit which is endless consciousness.

This complex Essential Oil affects our subtle being in many different ways and thus has a considerable influence on our chakras. Its greatest virtue is to connect the kundalini force, which is seated in the first chakra, with the crown chakra (7th chakra).





SANDALWOOD

The fragrance of this therapeutic grade Essential Oil revives feelings of exotic sensuality and spiritual entity – divine sensuality.

By adjusting the chakras and the subtle body, Sandalwood enables us to sense surrounding subtle energies while being seated firmly in the physical. Sandalwood acts grounding, brings us closer to our divine essence, supports us in times of fear and allows us to give ourselves totally to the divine will.

It stimulates the pituitary and the pineal gland which may help to reprogram the brain. This substance supports our endocrin system and is rich in molecules similar to androgen (male hormone). At the same time it has regulatory effects on the uterus.





Sandalwood

It consists of 90% sesquiterpenes. Sesquiterpenes increase the body's and brain's oxygen supply by filtering oxygen molecules out of food and air. The high level of oxygen stimulates amygdala, pineal and pituitary gland. It is assumed that Aloes used to be the Sandalwood of the Bible – a spice from ancient Palestine.

"He was accompanied by Nicodemus, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night. Nicodemus brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds." ~ The Gospel according to John, 19:39





CASSIA

Similar to cinnamon but sweeter and more pleasant is the fragrance of cassia. This Oil enhances blood circulation, supports heart function and strengthens the will. It simulated the 2nd chakra, especially for postmenopausal women. It is goog to be used in the morning when we feel muddled up. On the energetic plane Cassia releases memories of bondage and slavery which are buried in our subconscience. Thereby it reveals to us the reasons for our rebellious and unwilling behavior.

Cassia consist of 80% phenylpropanes. Phenylpropanes increase our electromagnetic frequency what offers benefit to our spiritual development and physical health. In ancient times cassia was used along with frankincense for temple incense. (further Oils which are rich in phenylpropanes are: clove 90%, basil 75%, nutmeg 75%, cinnamon 73%)

"Moreover, the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Take also for yourself the finest of spices: of flowing myrrh five hundred shekels, and of fragrant cinnamon half as much, two hundred and fifty, and of fragrant cane (calamus aromaticus) two hundred and fifty, and of cassia five hundred, according to the shekel of the sanctuary, and of olive oil a hin. You shall make of these a holy anointing oil, a perfume mixture, the work of a perfumer; it shall be a holy anointing oil. With it you shall anoint the tent of meeting and the ark of the testimony.....

.....You shall also consecrate them, that they may be most holy; whatever touches them shall be holy. You shall anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister as priests to Me. You shall speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'This shall be a holy anointing oil to Me throughout your generations. It shall not be poured on anyone's body, nor shall you make any like it in the same proportions; it is holy, and it shall be holy to you." ~ Exodus 30:22-26, 29-32





Steadiness and balance are the messages of Cedarwood. It embodies integrity, stability and solidarity with all things and beings. Cedarwood has the ability to strengthen us when we burnt ourselves out, loved too much, are unable to forgive. It supplies us with strength and courage, which we need to continue our way, focus on our dreams and realize our hopes.

Inhalation of cedarwood calms the overactive mind. Use cedarwood before business meetings for more clarity and to keep the meeting to the point.





The purifying quality of cedarwood, helps us to eliminate toxic emotions from our subtle body. It adjusts the heart chakra – thereby the mental and the physical being – and gives us the experience of a just existence

Cedarwood revives memories of true spiritual love and gives us a feeling of total security and protection through that love.

Cedarwood has been used for over 6,500 years by many different cultures such as the Tibetan and Egyptian cultures. Nowadays it is still used in Tibetan medicine and as a support for meditation by Tibetan Buddhists and other cultures.





Cedarwood is supposed to strengthen spirituality and the connection to God. Under that aspect it was used to build temples which symbolize these qualities.

Cedarwood Oil is a strong expectorant (it frees us from catarrh) likewise it is able to remove our "mental catarrh" when we use it for our subtle being. This mental catarrh obstructs our mind in the same way the physical catarrh obstructs our nose.

The cedar tree, which is used by North American natives for purifying ceremonies is a type of juniper.

It consists of 98% sesquiterpenes which puts it 1st before Vetiver (97%), Spikenard (93%) and sandalwood (90%).

The "Cedar of Lebanon" gave the fragrant and long lasting wood, of which the temple of Solomon was build.

"He spoke about plant life, from the cedar of Lebanon to the hyssop that grows out of walls." ~ 1, Kings 4:33





Cypress Oil supports us in times of transition (e.g.: changes in the job, menopause) and in making great spiritual decisions. It is also helpful when it comes to painful changes like loss or broken relationship.

The frequency of Cypress Oil lies between those of the physical and subtle plane. Therefore it can give us strength and consolation in the process of dying.

Cypress brings back the ability to flow with the life river without fear and without worries about the next step – where it will lead us and what it will bring about. It offers strength and energetic protection to those who are vulnerable and insecure and to those who lost their purpose of life. It may support us when it is time to let go and move on.





Empaths have to make a conscious effort to use their ability in a divine way. When used in a divine way empathetic properties can give us important information about neglected and suppressed energies on the metal, vital and emotional plane.

Divine usage brings to the fore the proper empathetic energy which stays in touch just long enough to interpret received information. Then the properly used energy separates itself from the object totally and consciously. After receiving information from the empath it is the individuals decision how and if he wants to act in that specific situation. In this way the empathic recipient does not have the risk of creating a karmic bond between him and the individual.





By applying it on the spleen's reflex point (below left chest side) we solve energetic blockades and improve metabolism. When Cypress is applied on gastrointestinal and womb area it releases stagnating energetic patterns and connected belief.

From the energetic point of view Cypress releases patterns of attachment from the spleen area. Attachment occurs when an empathetic relationship or empathetic bond becomes too strong. Often this is the case in relationships between healers and their patients and may exhaust the healers energy. Emotional nursing staff also tends to be empathetic. Absorbed with the wish to make others feel better the staff is not aware of the karmic consequences. This Oil is distilled from the wood of the cypress tree. Its wood is so enduring – after 1200 years the dors of the St. Peter's Basilica in Rome do not show decay. According to tradition Noah's ark was build out of cypress wood.

"So Hiram supplied Solomon with all the timber of cedar and cypress that he desired" ~ 1 Kings5:10

"The glory of Lebanon shall come to you, the cypress, the plane, and the pine, to beautify the place of my sanctuary, and I will make the place of my feet glorious. " ~ Isaiah 60:13





Also known as Olibanum, Frankincense is a sweet divine protector, which operates far beyond the aura, in the world of light. It is very flexible and adapts to the individual's spiritual status. Frankincense oil contains the wisdom of all ages. It awaits the demand and can do anything it is asked for.

When it senses attached hostile energies, frankincense has the power and the authority to assist a person in the removal of those forces.

In case of spiritual shock or loss, when the spirit wants to leave the body, frankincense can lead us gently back to our "home".. It enables each individual to be in touch with the eternal and divine within him. It is one of the oldest Oils and has been used for over 3000 years.





Frankincense increases oxygen supply and thus strengthens physical vitality. Having the ability to slow down and deepen our breath, frankincense leads us into a meditative state of consciousness.

It supports us in cutting off bonds which connect us to the past, especially when they hinder our personal growth. Use it for bathing with the intention to wash of those bonds that feel like hindrances.

MYRRH

Confining emotions create a very dense and exhausting feeling. Many people think they would protect themselves by suppressing their heart's emotions – truth is, it keeps them in a state of separation, which increases their false belive and illusion. These neglected emotions surround the aura like walls or armor plates and hinder the physical body in receiving new life force.

These surrounding walls make the abidance in the physical body uncomfortable. Myrrh's energy gives us the feeling of being shrouded in love, which pushes off negative and harmful influence and enables the heart to remain open and receptive.

Galbanum may uncover grief, insincerity and wrongdoing against the soul. It communicates with deeper planes of the self and enables a gradual revelation of the truth. Galbanum Oil is used to balance extreme or intense emotions.



HYSSOP

Hyssop has a long history as the purifying herb. It was used by both Egyptians and Hebrews. You may use it to purify any room in which you want to meditate, pray or heal.

The banishment of out-dated belive, which hinders our spiritual progress, calms the inner conflict of different realities. Thereby the dense feeling of fear may be released from the emotional, metal, physical and ethereal body. Hyssop dissolves density in the aura, which was caused by the mind's chitchat. Hyssop is the protecting herb of heaven. It is endowed with divine love and protection.

Hyssop initiates divine self acceptance and attracts the joy and happiness we lost by carrying the burdon of guilt and duty. It expands the energy of the lungs by releasing guiltiness.





Hyssop

On the energetic plane Hyssop enables the discovery of hidden fear, which lies buried in the unconscious mind. By releasing stress from the nervous system hyssop allows us to become aware of how our nerves have been burdened with this stress. Hyssop teaches us to be less stiff and inflexible and more gentle to our self. It decreases the drive to follow fanatic beliefs and allows the

energy to relax.
